WHAT YOU STUDY

The MGPP is offered as a 16, 24 or 32 unit program (equivalent to two, three or four semesters of full-time study), depending on your undergraduate qualification and experience working in policy contexts.

The programs consist of three elements:

- A suite of essential courses which will teach you about the foundations of contemporary governance and public policy.
- A newly designed series of study areas which allow you to reflect on the most pressing policy issues of the day. They include international policy, governance and development, designing social and community policy, and resource management.
- A selection of practical, skills-based courses that allow you to enhance your employability and to produce research independently. This final component includes internships, research and independent study opportunities that allow you to tailor your studies to your specific aspirations.
