Application for enrolment in HONOURS in Political Science and International Studies

This is a restricted entry program and requires prior approval from the School.

The program allows students of exceptional ability to engage in advanced research-related course work and the development of a research thesis.

To be eligible for consideration applicants must have:

- completed all the required units of undergraduate program.
- completed a Major in Political Science, Peace and Conflict Studies, or International Relations
- a minimum GPA of 5.5 in their Political Science, Peace and Conflict Studies, or International Relations major
- written a 500-700 word research proposal that is submitted with this application

Application Process

The completed form and your research proposal must be sent to polsis@uq.edu.au

- This form must be submitted by **31 January**. (Please note there is no mid-year intake for Honours in POLSIS)
- Applications are assessed, students will be allocated a supervisor, and successful candidates will be notified
- Notification will be via email to your student account
- NB: Successful admission to the program is provisional on the School of Political Science and International Studies being able to allocate you appropriate supervision. In years of high demand this cannot always be guaranteed.
- Please also note that you may be allocated a supervisor other than those you have indicated below.
